### **Nominee Eligibility:**

Any member of the Civil Litigation Section of OBA in good standing is eligible to nominate a candidate by submission in writing, together with a curriculum vita outlining the nominee's qualifications (if required by the Committee). Unless required by the Committee, the nominator is not required to advise (or obtain the consent of) the nominee of the nomination prior to the nomination deadline.

### **Criteria for Nominee:**

#### **(Must meet one or more of the following criteria)**

- (i) the recipient's proven outstanding skills in oral and written advocacy;
- (ii) the recipient's contribution to legal education;
- (iii) the recipient's contribution to the community through pro bono work and other projects or initiatives;
- (iv) the recipient's leadership in the Civil Litigation Bar through sharing knowledge, experience, skill, commitment, by acting as a role model to the younger members of the profession as well as to his/her peers at the civil litigation bar;
- (v) the recipient's contributions to the development of civil litigation related policies, procedures, practice and legislation.
