

Brock Jones

Brock Jones was called to the Ontario Bar in 2005. After graduating from the Faculty of Law at the University of Toronto, Brock served as a law clerk to several judges of the Superior Court of Justice in Toronto. He then joined the Scarborough Crown Attorney's office. He has prosecuted all manner of youth cases in both the Ontario and Superior Courts of Justice. Brock was also Crown Counsel at the office of Crown Law—Criminal in Ontario between 2013 and 2016 and argued several youth justice cases before the Ontario Court of Appeal.

From 2012 – 2019 he was an adjunct professor of law at the Faculty of Law, University of Toronto, where he teaches a course on the Youth Criminal Justice Act. In 2016, he won the OBA's Heather McArthur Memorial Young Lawyers' Award for his contributions to legal education.

He is the co-author of *Prosecuting and Defending Youth Criminal Justice Cases* (Emond Publishing) and the *Children's Law Handbook*, 4<sup>th</sup> Edition (Carswell.)
