The OBA Award of Excellence in Pensions and Benefits Law was established to recognize exceptional contributions to the field of pensions and benefits law.

To be eligible for the OBA Award of Excellence in Pensions and Benefits Law, an individual must have made a significant contribution in one or more of the following areas: Enhancement of the practice of pensions and benefits law; Development of pensions and benefits law, including teaching, writing and advocacy; Leadership through participation in governmental/regulatory bodies and professional associations, including the OBA; Mentoring and teaching through the sharing of knowledge and experience; and Advocacy and/or adjudication.

Current members of the OBA Pensions and Benefits Section Executive and the OBA Executive are not eligible.
